

Footpath report

Over the year issues have been addressed where fallen trees/branches have obstructed the footpaths. This included when a swarm of bees were causing an issue on a footpath so they were quickly relocated by a village beekeeper. Signs have been trimmed round where next to hedges and fingerposts replaced and posts reinstated.

Back in June 2021 we were contacted by the Green access officer(rights of way team) with regards to fingerpost plaques. This was part of a two year project called Discovering Suffolk to raise awareness of Suffolk countryside and promote local outdoor activity. As part of this project we were asked to install new plaques on the roadside fingerposts which provided links to Discover Suffolk website.

I cut all the footpaths on our land and adjacent parishes throughout the summer months to make for easy walking and help define where the footpaths are.
