Achievements

- Completed carpentry for Long House timber frame walls and roof frame
- Made over 700 oak pegs for the frame
- Raised long house walls and roof frame including sprockets
- Fitted roof insulation
- Gained Building Regulation approval to use Light Straw Clay (hybrid daub) for wall insulation
- Harvested and managed 13,000L rainwater (totally 'off-grid' during 7 week drought)

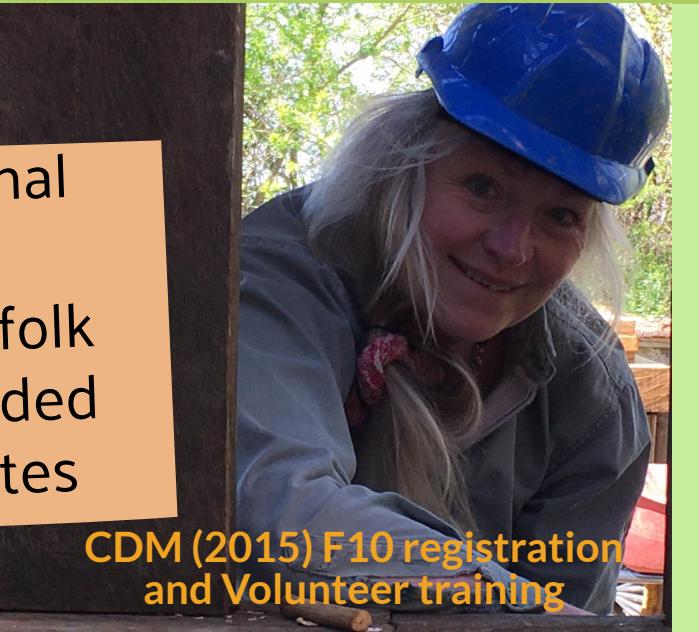

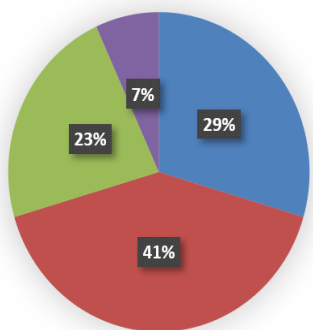

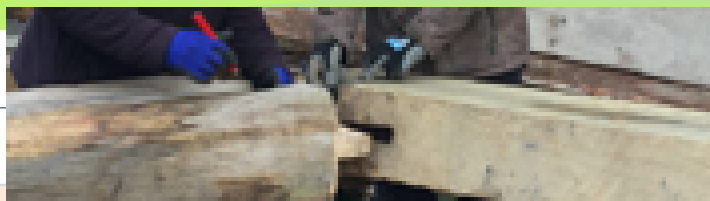
Volunteer Locations

Note: PLUS 44 'very occasional/one-off helpers' from unspecified locations.

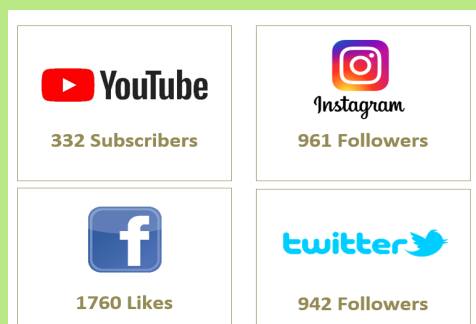
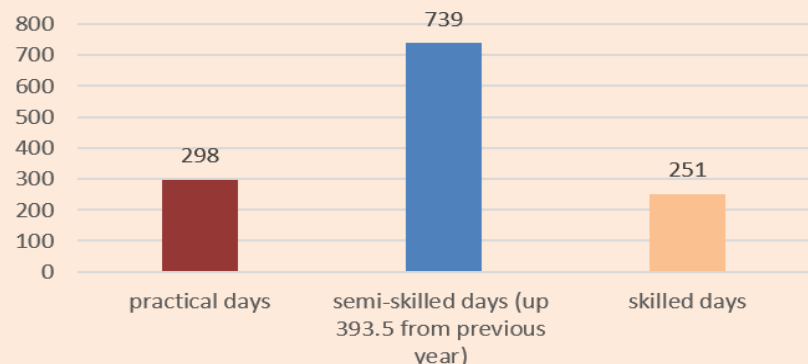
Total value of 'in-kind' Volunteer time during 21-22 was £275,600 (up £99,900 on previous year!)
